

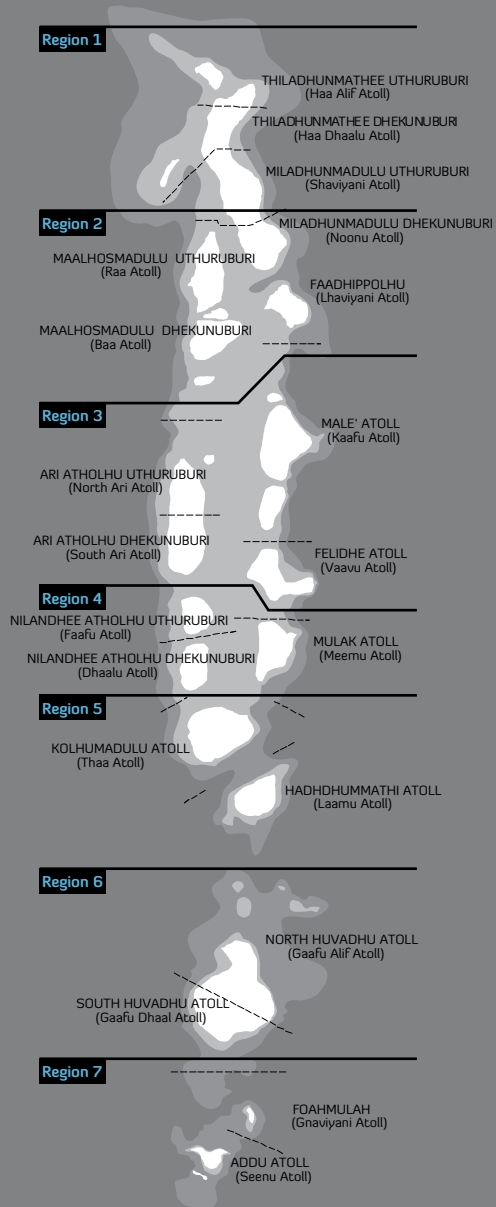

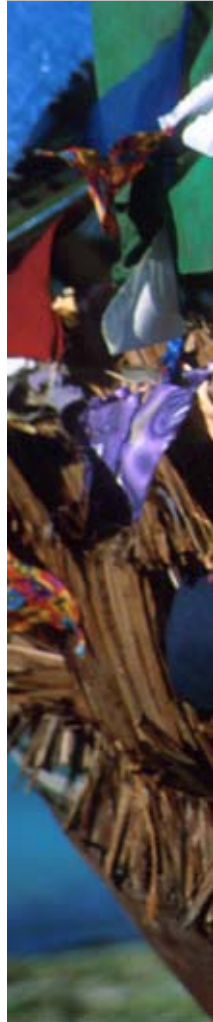


INTRODUCTION

The Government of Maldives is seeking a party to develop a comprehensive and sustainable transport system in the atolls of the Republic of Maldives.

The network would divide the archipelago to seven regions. Each region will have 20 to 50 ferry terminals.

Successful investors will be granted a appropriate incentives and concessions under the agreement.





Situation

Due to the lack of a public transport system in the Maldives residents of many islands stay in their islands or are forced to pay for over priced limited private transport to receive basic services.

Purpose

The Purpose is to develop a sustainable maritime land based transportation network to increase accessibility and mobility of people by incorporating existing networks of private and public transportation networks.

This network would ensure benefits of transportation are equally distributed and will be particularly focused on those with special needs, lower income residents, while benefiting the higher income residents and assisting economic regeneration within the country.

GOALS

1. Increase accessibility and mobility by providing nodes of transportation network within the country.
2. Increase economic regeneration at all levels through revitalization of urban setting and land use.
3. Enhance environmental sustainability by introducing renewable energy and thus making it more cost effective.
4. Provide affordable and safe transport for users.
5. Improve efficiency of the system by making traveling more scheduled.





THE SYSTEM

1. Intra atoll

All the islands within the atoll will be connected through frequent ferry arrival and departures. As illustrated here the ferries will be connecting islands A, B, C, D, E and F on a scheduled basis. Frequency of ferry arrivals and departures will be dependent on the population of each island.

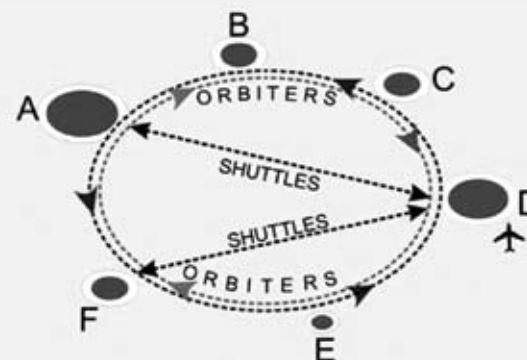


Fig.1 Typical model of intra atoll transportation network

2. Intra regional/inter atoll

Ferries will connect the major islands of each atoll (A, B, C, D) in each region.

All the islands within the atoll will be connected through frequent ferry arrival and departures.

As illustrated below the ferries will be connecting islands A, B, C, D, E and F on a scheduled basis.

Frequency of ferry arrivals and departures will be dependent on the population of each island.

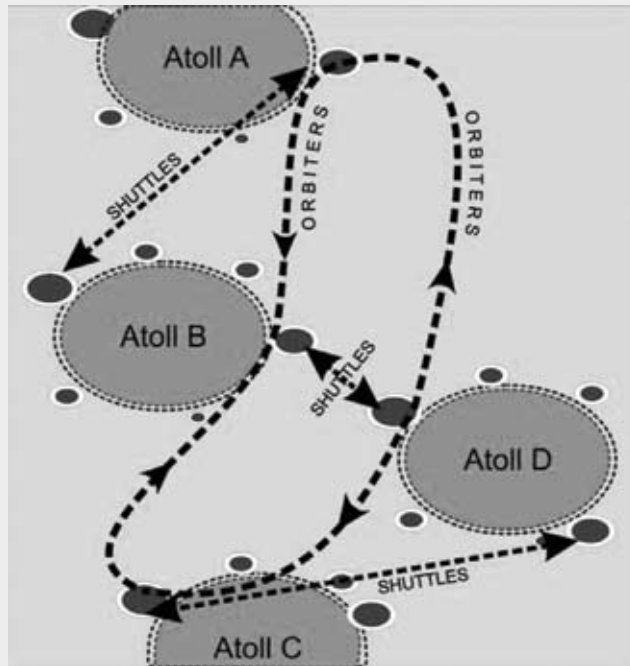


Fig.2 Typical intra regional or inter atoll transportation network

The illustration will be typical of transportation system at regional level. At national level ferries will connect the seven regions.

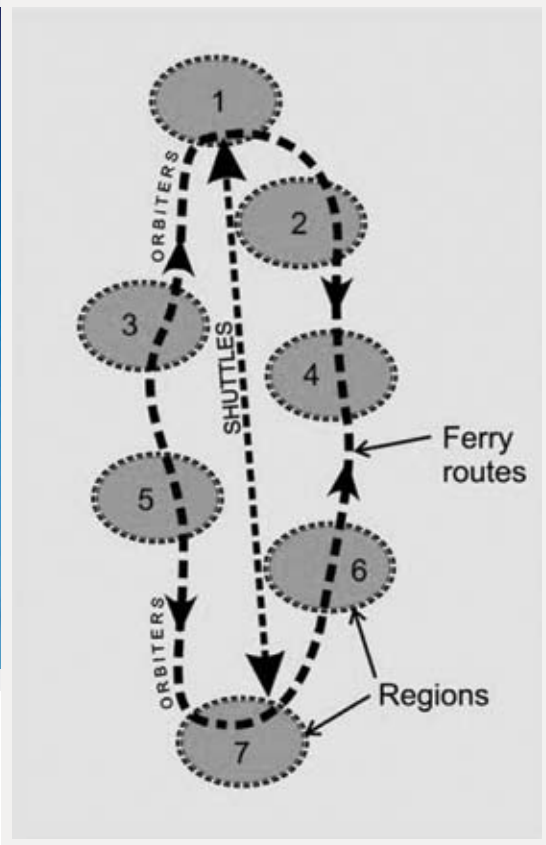
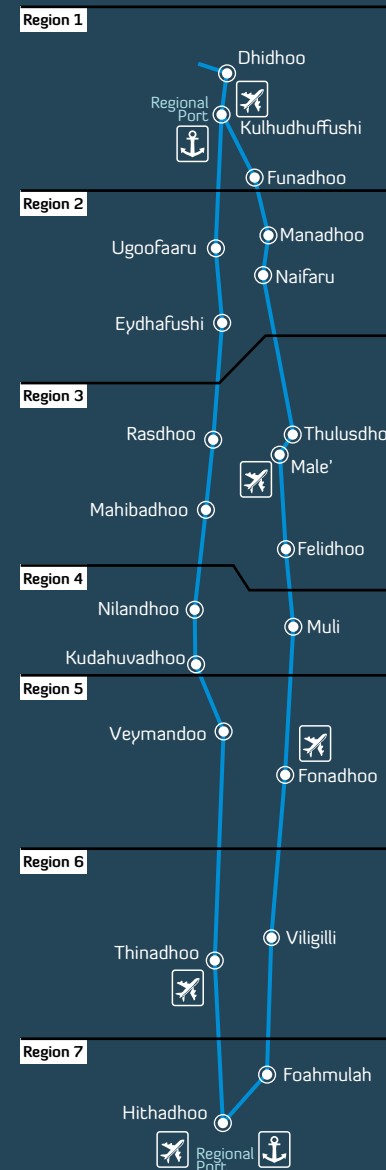
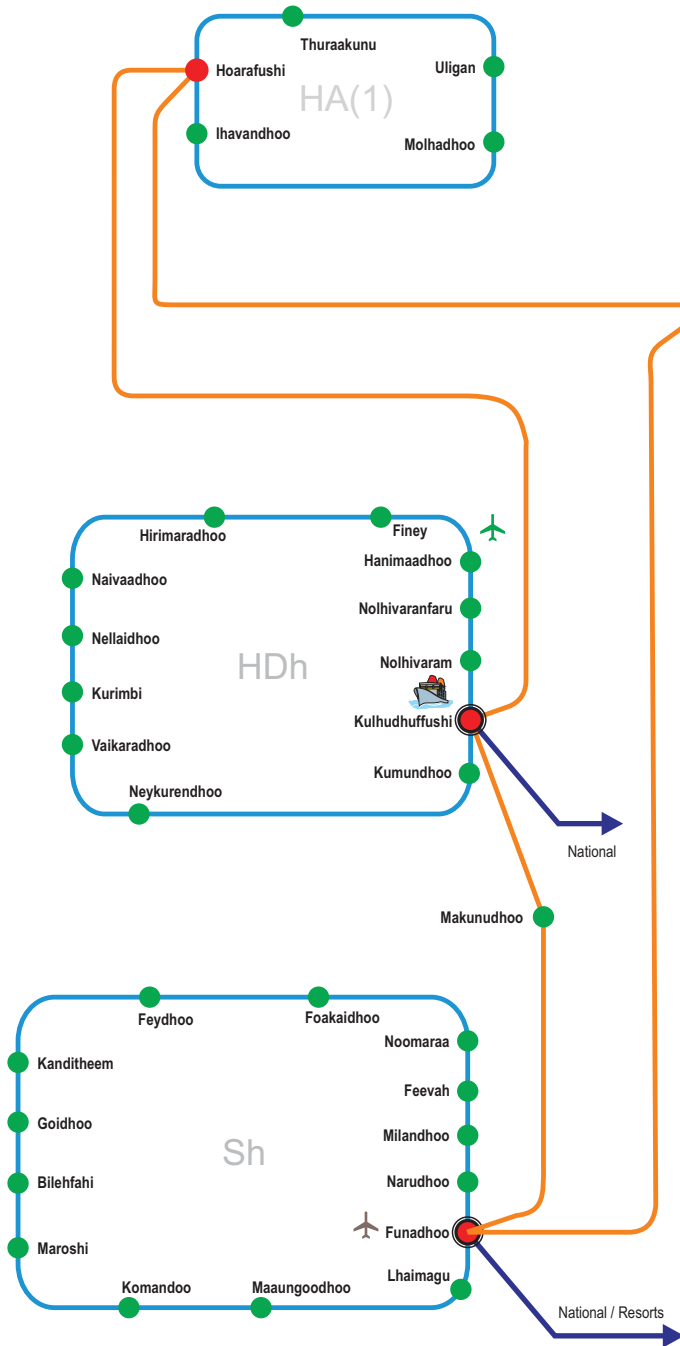


Fig.3 Transportation at inter regional or national level

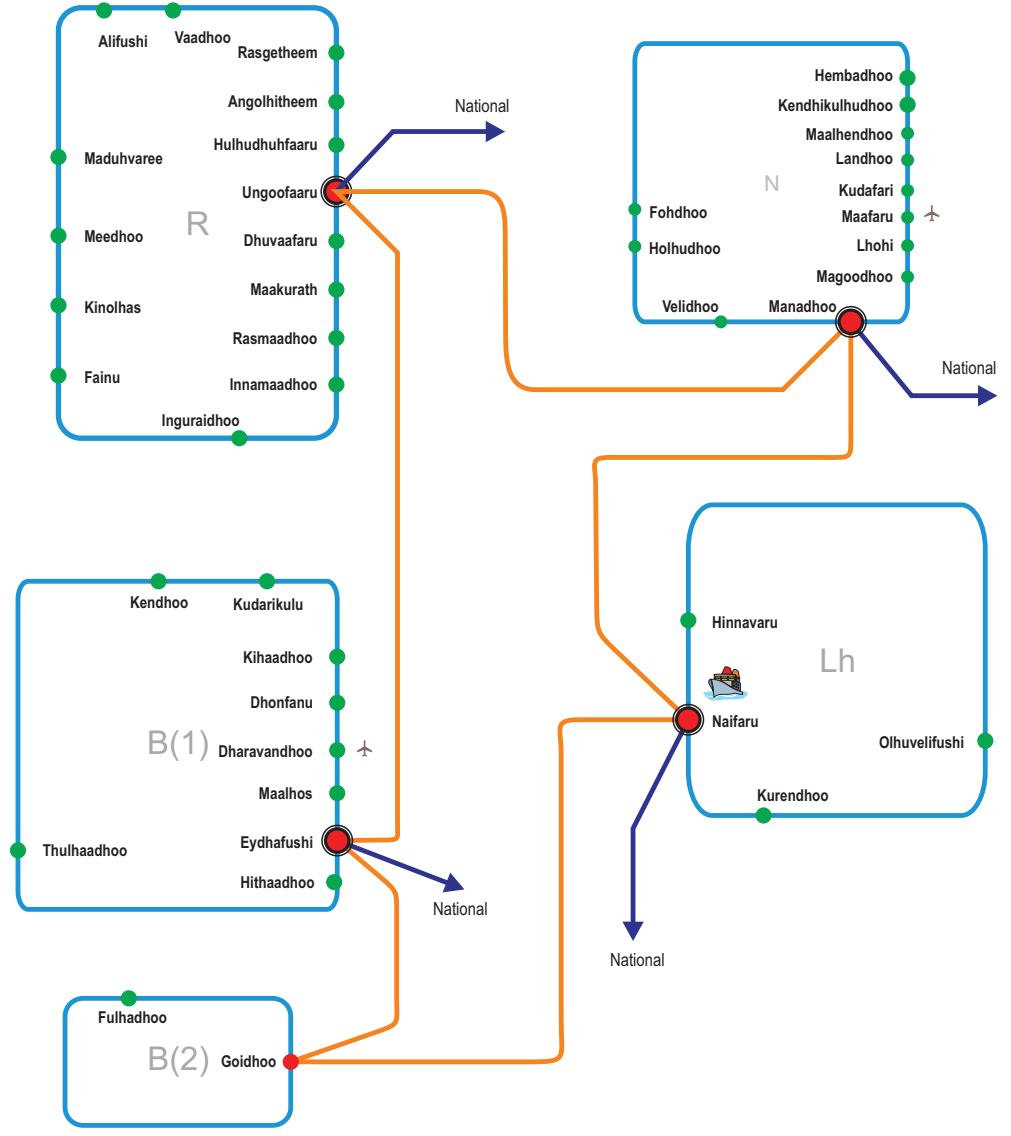

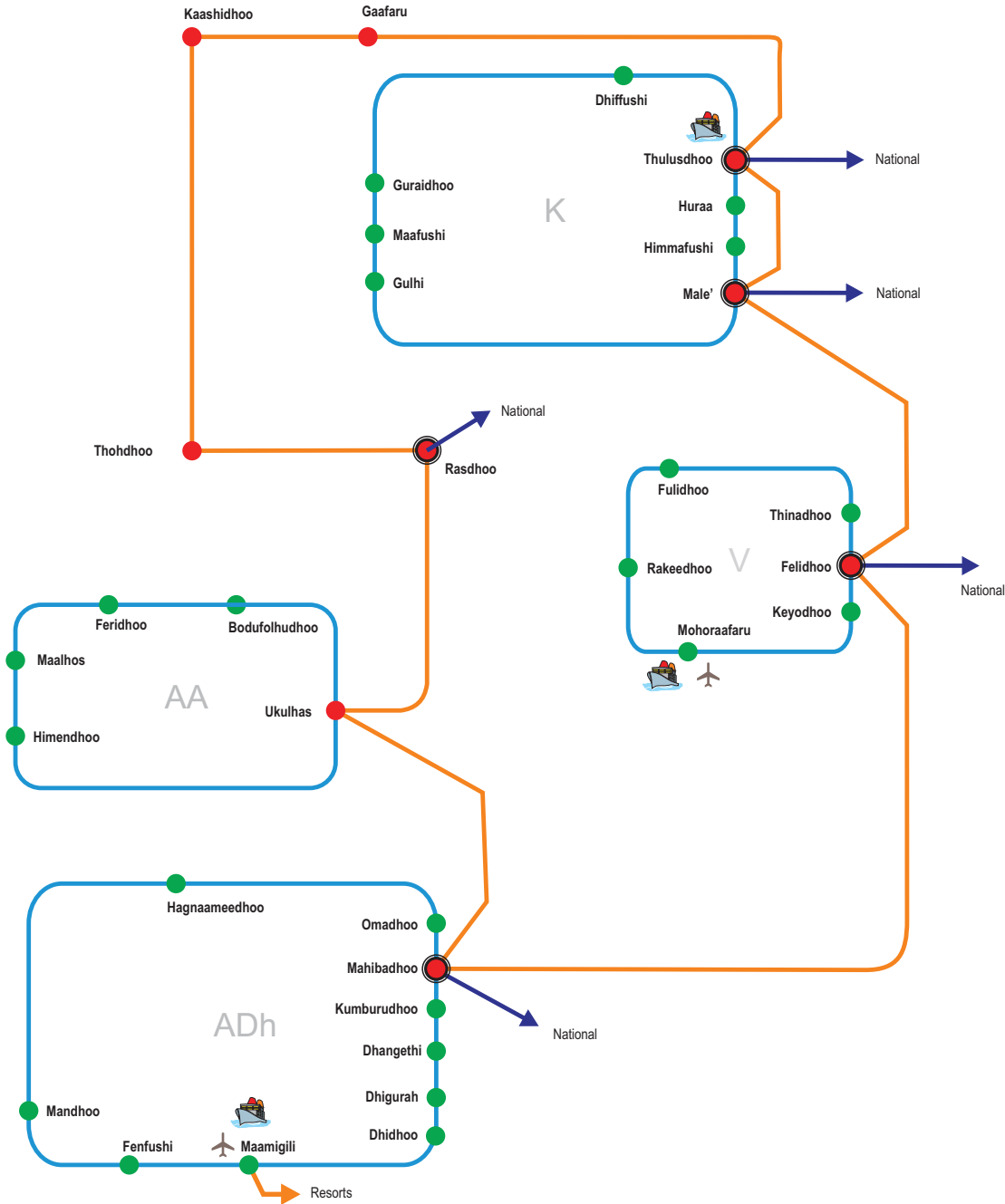

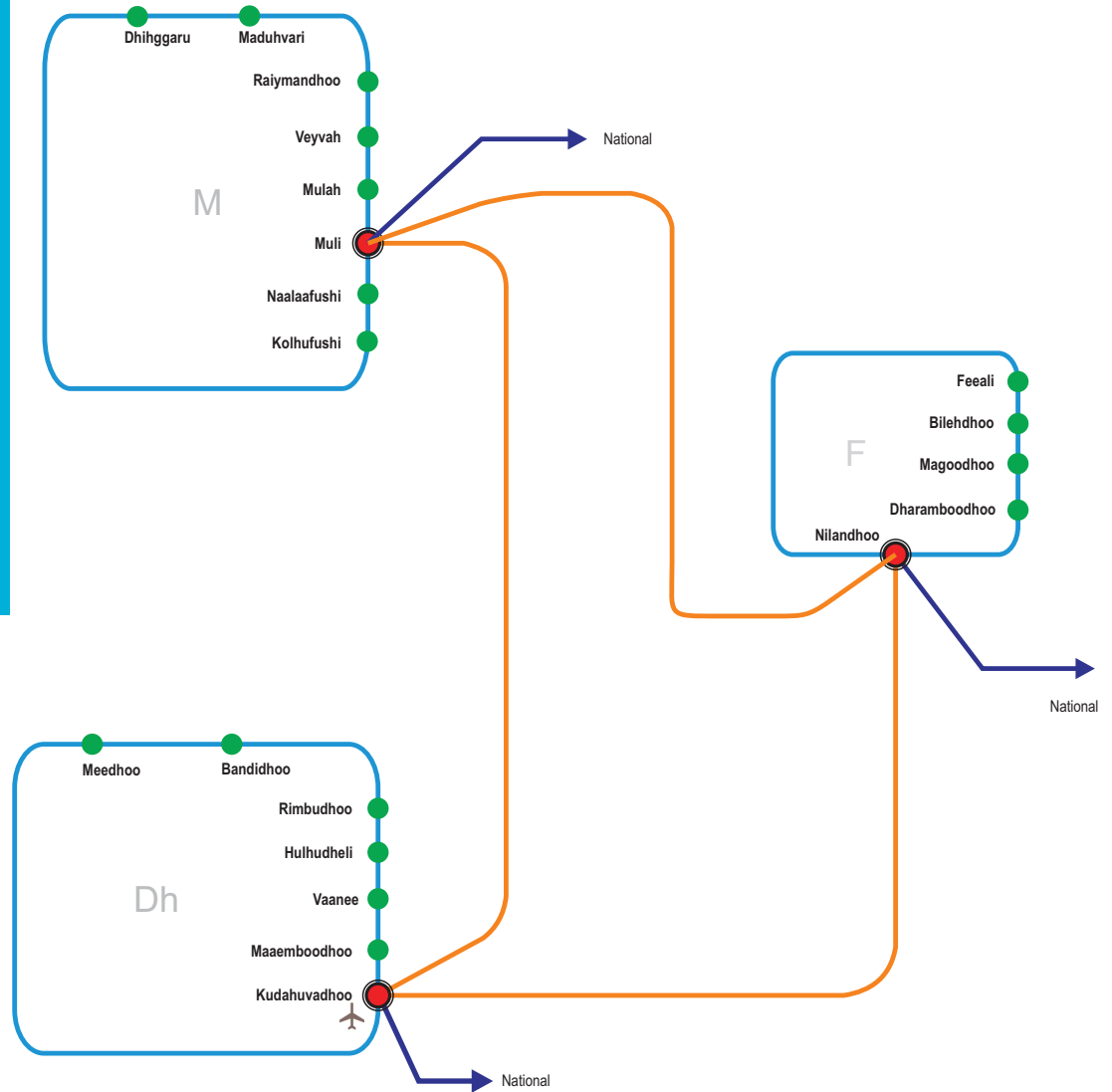


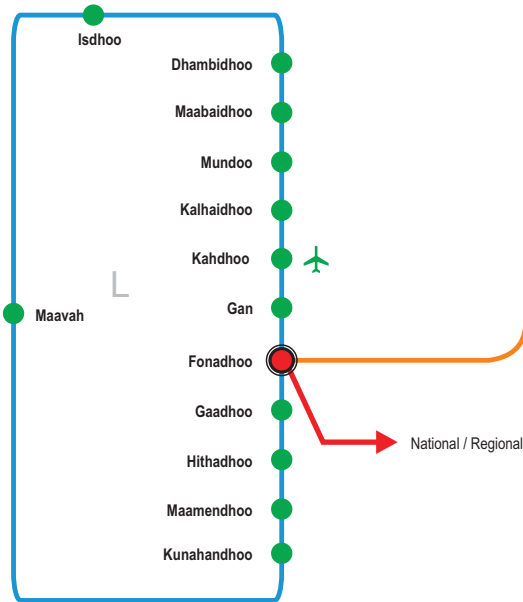
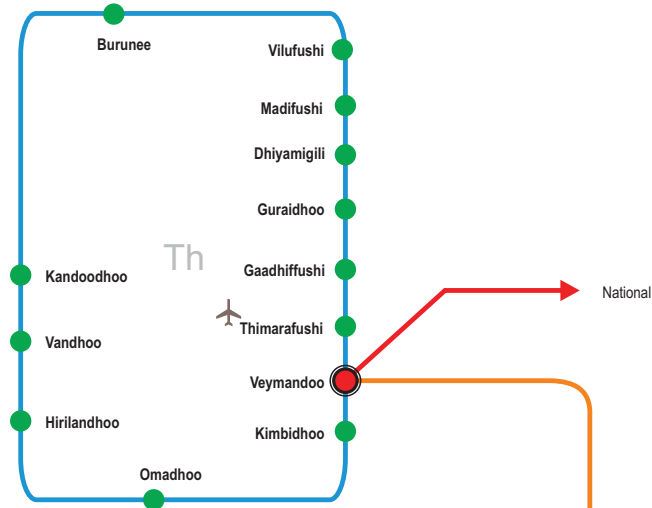

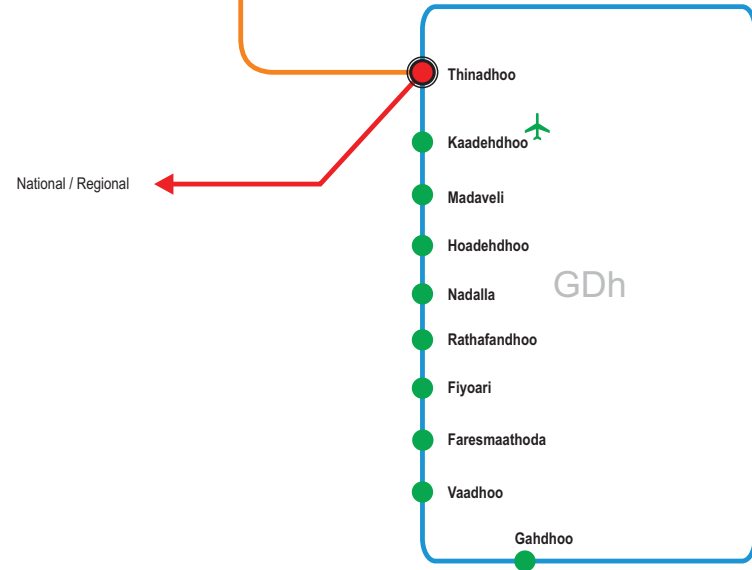

Inter-Island Transportation network

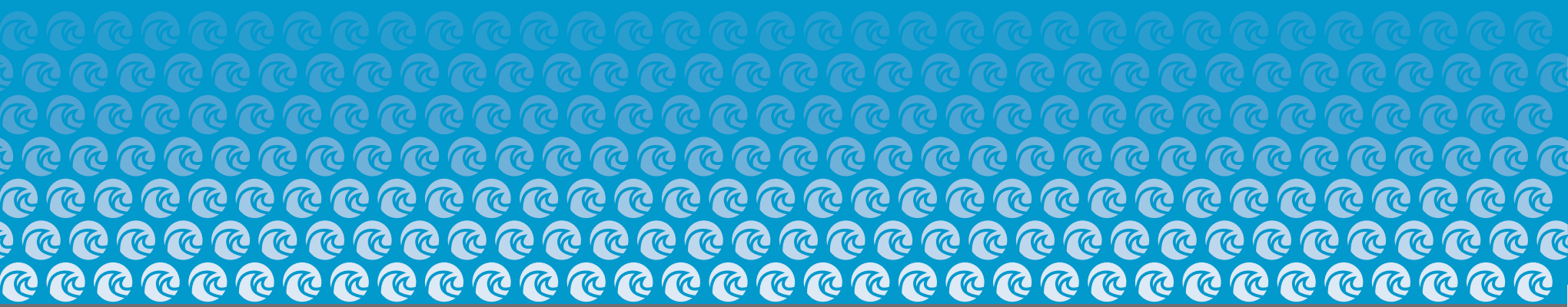
